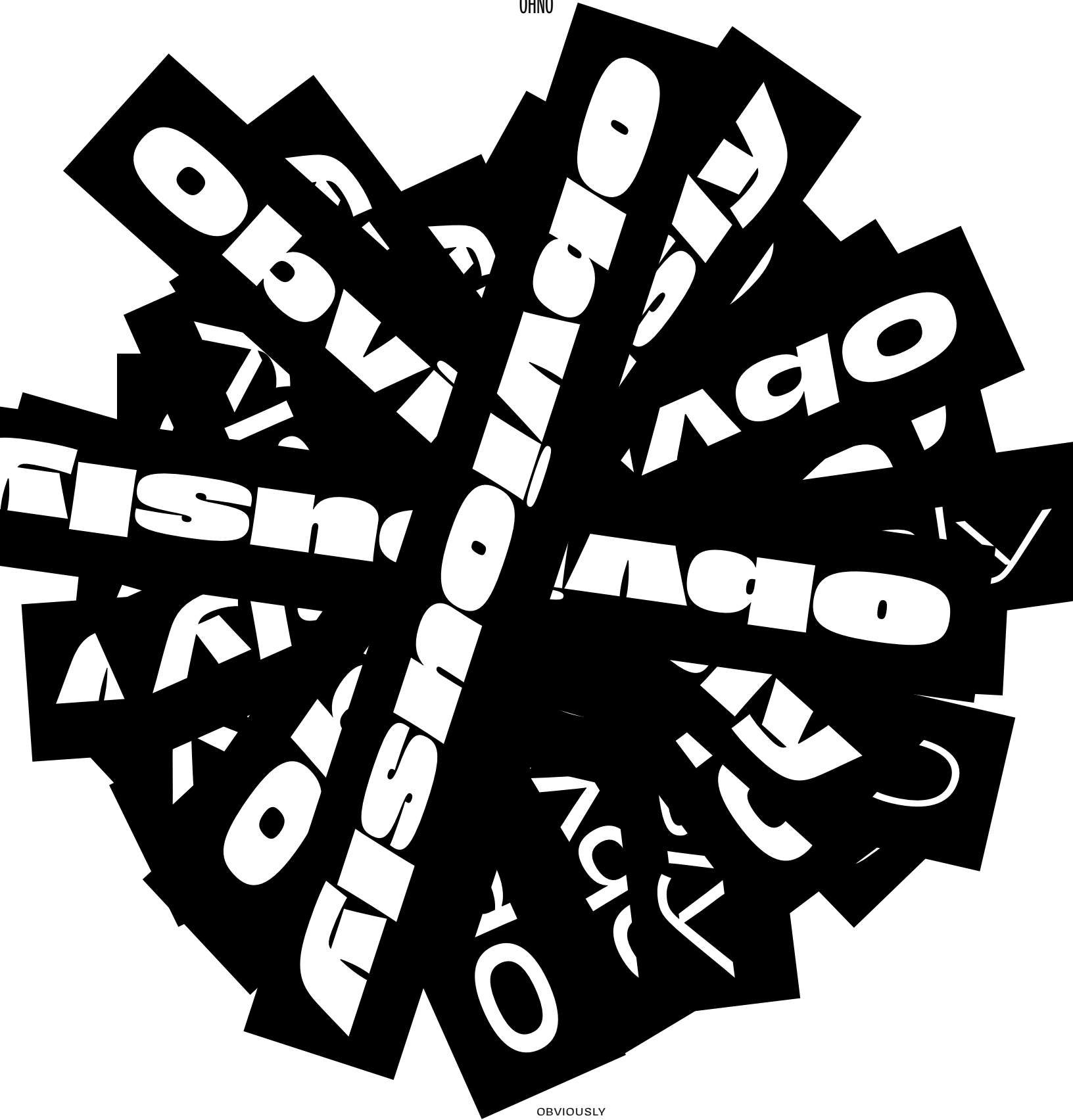

Stevland Hardaway Morris (born May 15, 1950), better known by his stage name Stevie Wonder, is an American singer, songwriter, instrumentalist. A child prodigy, Wonder is considered to be one of the most critically and commercially successful musical performers with Motown's Tamla label at the age of 11, and he continued performing and recording for Motown into the 2010s. He has been his works are singles such as "Signed, Sealed, Delivered I'm Yours", "Superstition", "Sir Duke", "You Are the Sunshine of My Life", and "I Just Called to Say Hello to My ex-Talking Book, Innervisions, and Songs in the Key of Life. He has recorded more than 30 U.S. top ten hits and received 25 Grammy Awards and has sold over 100 million records worldwide, making him one of the top 60 best-selling music artists. Wonder is also noted for including his 1980 campaign to make Martin Luther King Jr.'s birthday a holiday in the United States. In 2009, Wonder was named Billboard magazine released a list of the Billboard Hot 100 All-Time Top Artists to celebrate the US singles chart's 55th anniversary.

Financial independence is a state in which an individual or household has sufficient wealth to live on without having to depend on anyone else for money. Financially independent people have assets that generate income (cash flow) that is at least equal to their expenses. Income generated in this way is referred to as "passive income." For example, if someone receives \$5000 in dividends from stocks they own, but their expenses total \$4000, they are financially independent because it pays for all their expenses to live (with some left over). Under these circumstances, a person is financially independent. An important factor in determining if they have achieved financial independence. An asset is anything of value that can be readily converted into cash without incurring debt, whereas a liability is a responsibility to provide compensation. (Homes and automobiles with no liens or mortgages are considered assets.) Salary doesn't matter - if someone can generate enough income to meet their needs from sources other than their primary occupation, they are financially independent. If a 25-year-old has \$100 in expenses per month, and assets that generate \$101 or more per month, they have achieved financial independence and can spend their time doing the thing they enjoy without needing to work a regular job to pay their bills. If, on the other hand, a 50-year-old has \$100 in expenses per month, but assets that generate only \$99 per month, they are not financially independent because they still have to earn the difference each month. The effects of inflation must be considered. If a person needs \$100/month for living expenses today, they will need \$105/month next year to support the same lifestyle, assuming a 5 percent annual inflation rate. Therefore, if the person in the above example obtains their financial independence at a time when they lose their financial independence because of inflation.

He is currently signed to Columbia Records as well as his independent label Tan Cressida.

Inflation must be considered. If a person needs \$100/month for living expenses today, they will need \$105/month next year to support the same lifestyle, assuming a 5 percent annual inflation rate. Therefore, if the person in the above example lives on their assets in perpetuity, there will be a time when they lose their financial independence because of inflation.
